

SnowCone Machine

Instructions

- 1) PLUG THE MACHINE IN AND START THE MOTOR.
- 2) FILL THE GOOSENECK WITH CRUSHED ICE OR ICE CUBES, BROKEN INTO PIECES 3-4 INCHES IN SIZE. A 20 LB BAG OF ICE WILL MAKE APPROX 40-50 6 oz CONES!
- 3) FILL TO ABOUT AN INCH OR SO, FROM THE TOP THE LARGER THE PIECE OF ICE, THE BETTER THE 'SNOW'!
- 4) PUSH THE HANDLE DOWNWARD TO PRESS THE ICE AGAINST THE CUTTER HEAD.
- 5) DO NOT PUT YOUR FINGERS OR HANDS, INSIDE THE 'GOOSENECK' YOU WILL GET CUT!
- 6) A FIRM AND EVEN PRESSURE IS ALL THAT IS REQUIRED, BUT SOMETIMES, YOU WILL FIND IT BETTER TO RELIEVE THE PRESSURE 2 OR 3 TIMES ON THE WAY DOWN. THIS LETS THE ICE REARRANGE ITSELF AND YOU GET A BETTER 'BITE'.
- 7) DO NOT FORCE THE HANDLE TOO MUCH, AS THE MOTOR COULD BE STALLED. WHEN TOO MUCH PRESSURE BECOMES NECESSARY, RELIEVE THE HANDLE AND THEN COME DOWN ON IT AGAIN.
- 8) <u>DO NOT APPLY PRESSURE ON HANDLE UNTIL THE MOTOR IS UP TO SPEED!</u> TOO MUCH PRESSURE ON THE 'PUSH HANDLE' WILL MAKE THE ICE COME OUT TOO COARSE TOO LITTLE PRESSURE MAKES THE ICE MUSHY.
- 9) DURING NORMAL MACHINE OPERATION, THE MOTOR GETS WARM A SURFACE TEMPERATURE OF 150 DEGREES FAHRENHEIT IS NORMAL.

DO NOT ALLOW ANY OBJECTS (METAL, WOOD, PLASTIC, ETC) TO GET DOWN INTO THE 'GOOSENECK' OR YOU WILL RUIN THE BLADES. THE BLADES ARE MADE OF TEMPERED STEEL AND SHOULD LAST A FULL SEASON WITHOUT REPLACEMENT.
